McCurtain County reports June's highest county unemployment rate

In June 2010, **McCurtain County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 11.3 percent. **Latimer County** claimed the state's second highest rate, and **Hughes County** recorded June's third highest county rate. **Beaver County** held onto the state's lowest county rate at 3.7 percent for the month. Three counties (**Grant, Harper, Murray**) tied for the second lowest county rate in June, and **Cimarron County** claimed sole possession of the month's third lowest county rate.

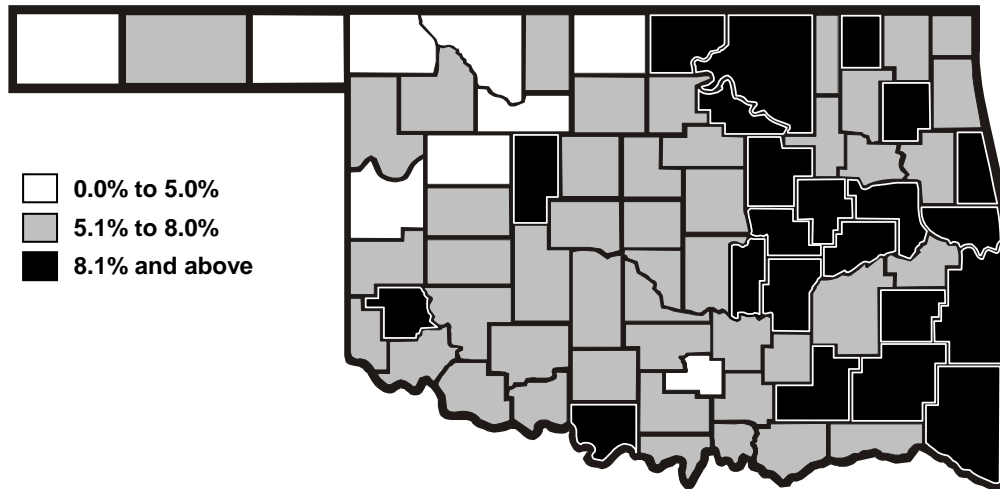
